

## PROBE Iceland Volcano Museum

Located in the proximity of shore of lake Myvatyn in northern Iceland, the project incorporates a design for a museum with indoor and outdoor functions based on the seasons and the types of visitors in this region.

A winding path draws us to explore the distinct compositions of the silhouette of the site. It then opens to a rigid mass which evokes a sense of being mysterious, stimulating strong emotions.

The architecture of this building enables the surroundings to reveal itself. The dark facade of the edifice lets nature take over; the mirror cladding responds to the dynamic surroundings which in turn augment the northern lights. The mirror allows merging the building with the landscape. The hues of the northern light reflect their environment and each moment gives the structure a feeling of lightness.
