

At ground level, the 'blank space', which can be rented out as a cafe, office or shop, functions as a bottle shop. The fittings and furnishings of the bottle shop are left bare to the discretion of the tenant. This lowers construction costs and avoids unecessary renovation which would be environmentally tiresome.

On the first floor, the bedroom of 'family apartment' is seen. The bedroom is minimal and contains only a wardrobe, bed and window. The window is deep, allowing it to become a window seat for guests or private contemplation. The louvres opposite capitalise on terraces' suitability for cross-ventilation and make the hallway feel light and open.

The rooftop is a semi-public space; a mirror of the street below. The rooftop includes amenities such as a vegetable garden, laundry, barbeques and gathering spaces. The rooftop is accessed either by staircases at each building, or the elevator in the community square.
